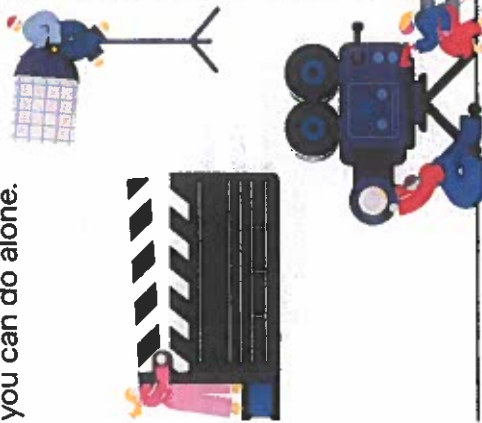


Cast and Crew: Everyone has a part to play

Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, remind them of how much Jesus loves them . . . and you do, too!



Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "How can we work together as a family to point people to Jesus?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "Who is someone you know who loves Jesus? What is it about them that makes you think that?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "Jesus, use our family to point people to You by our actions and words. May the people we meet see how much love You have for us and them."

Point Them to Jesus

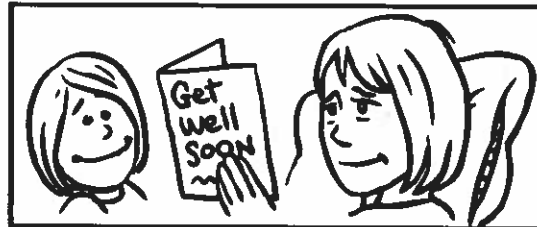
You can pray your own prayer, asking God to help you point others to Jesus, or pray the one below.

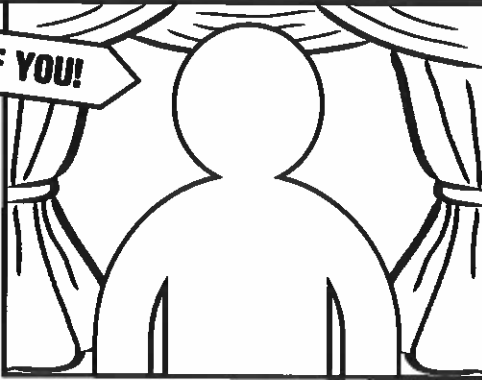

What part of your face do you think is the most important? **COLOR IT!**

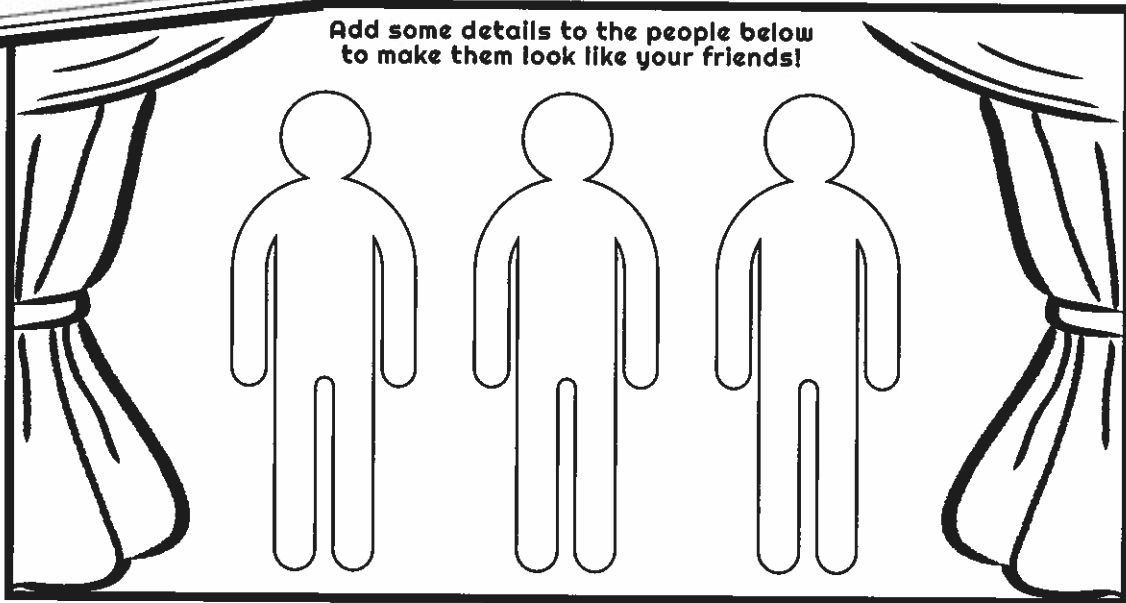

Narrator: CRASH! The whole body went down on the ground.

FEET: Okay NOSE, help us get up off of the floor!

NOSE: I'm trying! I'm trying! I just can't do it!

Narrator: So the body was just stuck there on the ground in a big pile of . . .

NOSE: Does anyone smell that?

EAR: No. Thank goodness.

Narrator: Just like our bodies need to cooperate to get us where we need to go, the people in the church need to cooperate to point people to Jesus and fulfill our mission of loving everyone.
