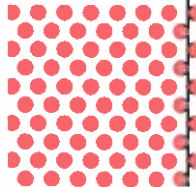


The Big Picture: Keep hope alive

Meal Time

At a meal this week, have everyone at the table answer this question: "Why does Easter give us hope?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What are some things that seem impossible?"



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "Jesus, help us remember that whatever happens, it's not too much for You. You overcame death and rose from the grave."

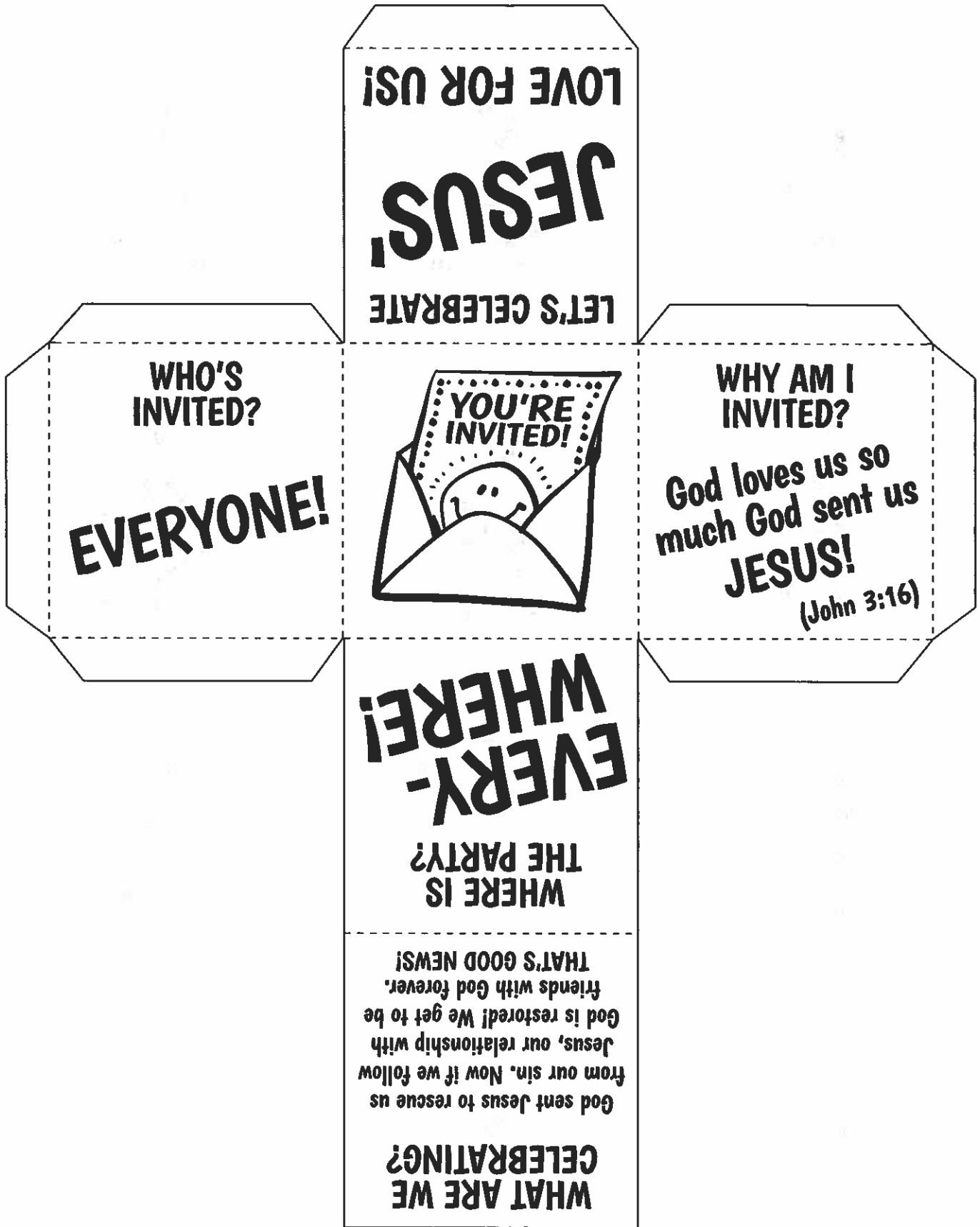

1. Who celebrated the Passover meal with Jesus?
(His friends/disciples)
2. Where did Jesus and His friends go to pray after the meal?
(The Garden of Gethsemane)
3. Who was the Roman Governor?
(Pilate)
4. Who denied knowing Jesus three times?
(Peter)
5. Who questioned Jesus at the trial after He was arrested?
(Annas and Caiaphas, the high priest)
6. What did Pilate say after interrogating Jesus?
("I find no basis for a charge against him" John 18:38)
7. What did the soldiers place on Jesus' head after He was whipped?
(A crown of thorns)
8. When Jesus was brought down from the cross, what was He placed in?
(A tomb)
9. On the third day, who ran told the disciples that Jesus was no longer in the tomb?
(Mary Magdalene)
10. Was Jesus really a criminal?
(No! Jesus was the Son of God who came to rescue us so we could have a relationship with God that lasts forever.)
11. What did Jesus tell Mary to do when He paid her a visit? (He instructed her to go tell His followers, "I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.")
12. What do we celebrate on Easter?
(Jesus is alive! He was crucified on the cross and then resurrected three days later, all so that we would not be separated from God.)



WHAT ARE WE CELEBRATING?
 God sent Jesus to rescue us from our sin. Now if we follow Jesus, our relationship with God is restored! We get to be friends with God forever. THAT'S GOOD NEWS!
