

What Is Needed?

"Dear God, help me to see the needs of those around me. Show me what to do to show I care and love them. Amen."


THANK God for helping you see others' needs.


INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Start by tying the end of the yarn securely to the Hula Hoop®.
- 2. Stretch the yarn across the Hula Hoop® to the opposite side and wrap it around the Hula Hoop®.
- 3. Wrap the yarn around the rim of that part of the Hula Hoop® several times.
- 4. Continue stretching the yarn across in different directions, creating a crisscross "web" pattern.
- 5. Once the web of yarn is complete, tie off the yarn securely to the Hula Hoop® and trim any excess.


