Summary: God gave King David great victories. He decided to bring back the ark of the covenant. He and the people had a great celebration, worshiping God along the way. David's wife, Michal, saw David dancing and worshiping, and she was angry. She ridiculed him for being an embarrassment, but David responded that he was willing to look even more foolish for God. 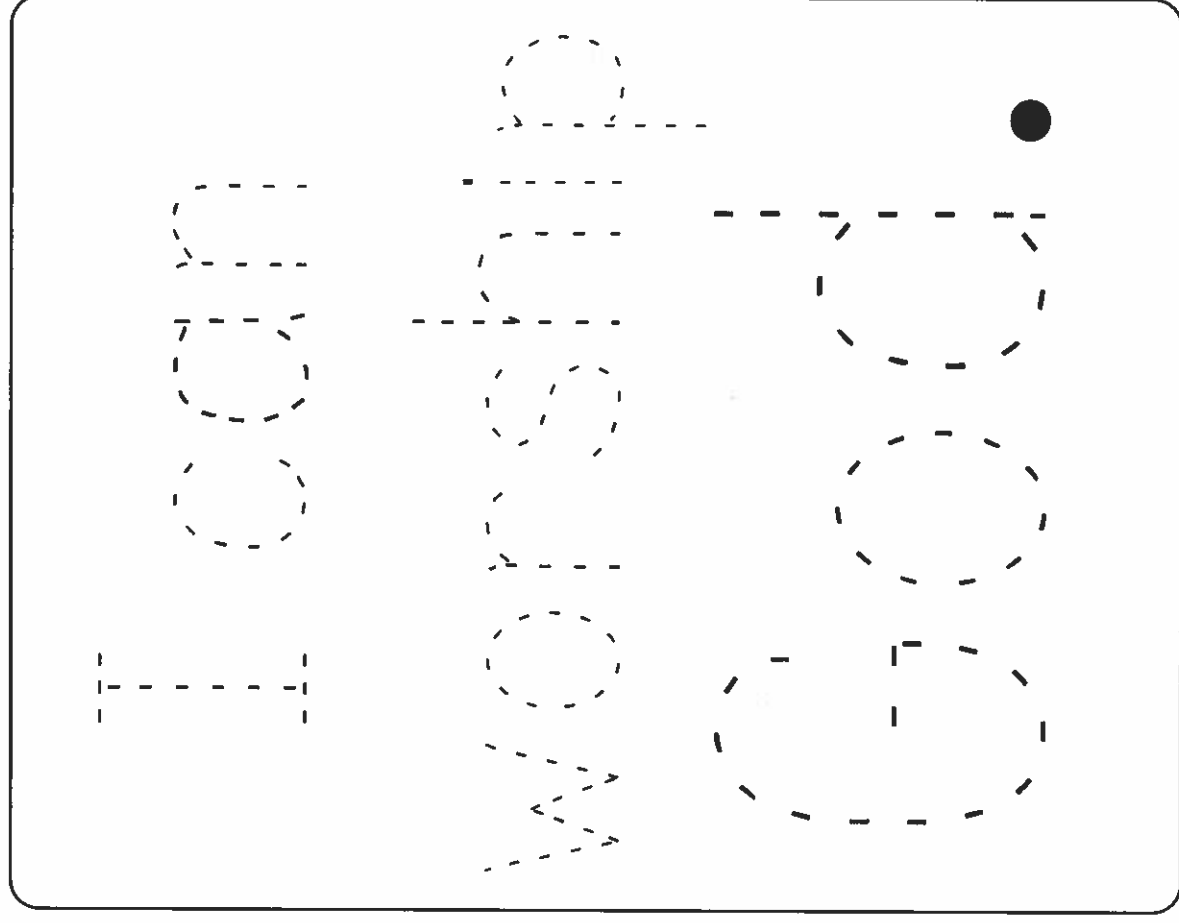
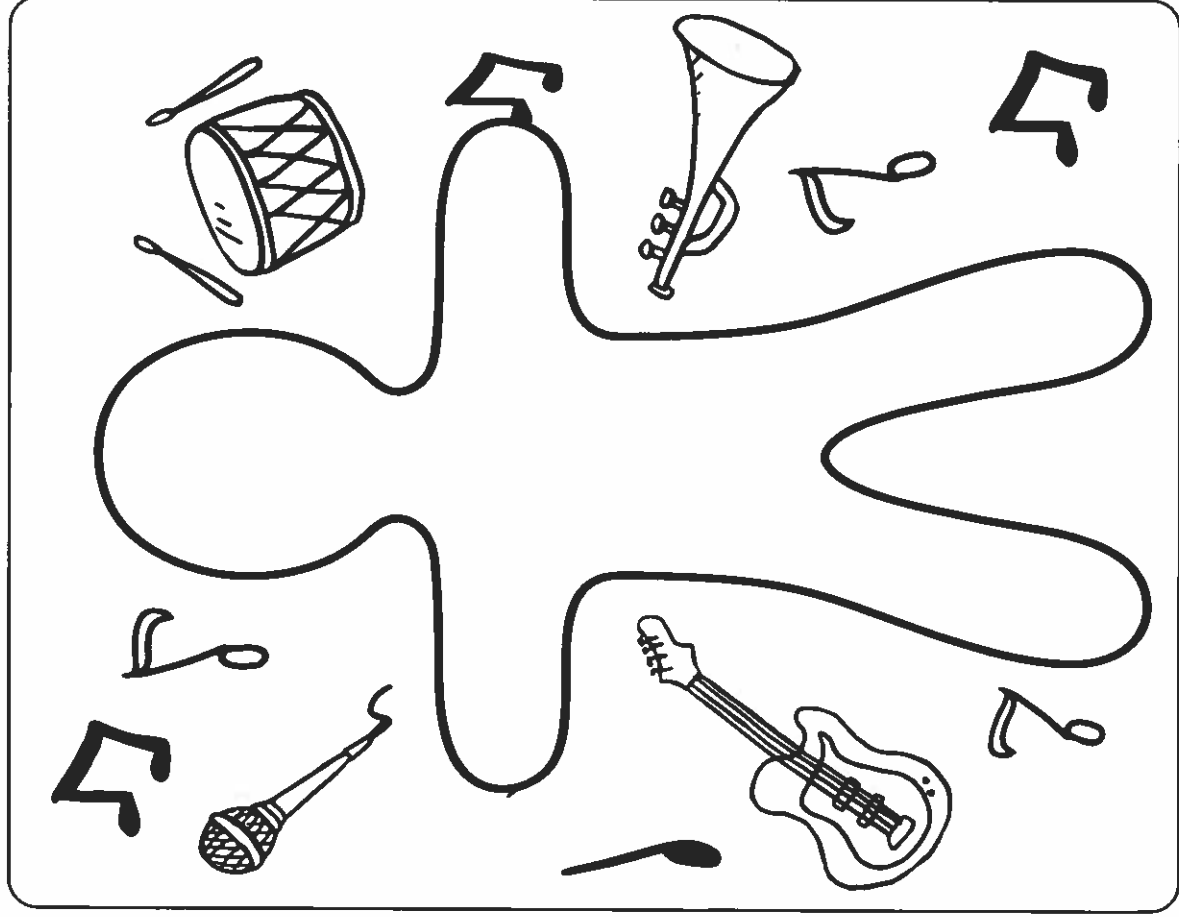

WEEK 1 God is the one true King. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Daniel 7:14. Who is part of God's kingdom?	Take turns pretending you are "king" of the house. How are you going to rule your "kingdom"?	PSALM 24:10 Who is the King this verse is talking about?	Make a list of specific ways to trust God to be the King of your family this week.	Play "This or That." Discuss any surprising answers. READ TOGETHER: 1 Samuel 16 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 2 God sees our hearts. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Proverbs 21:2 What does it mean to "weigh the heart"?	Make paper hearts together. Leave them around your home to remind each other that God sees your heart.	PSALM 24:10 How can we give glory to God?	Share what you notice about each other's hearts.	Go on a walk together. Worship God for His creation. READ TOGETHER: 2 Samuel 6:16-23 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 God is worthy of worship. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Psalm 150 What can we praise God for?	Create a collage with images that remind you of worshipping God.	PSALM 24:10 Why is God worthy of our worship?	Spend time worshipping God together through music.	Plan and create a family feast "fit for a king." READ TOGETHER: 2 Samuel 7 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 4 God promised a forever King. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Isaiah 40:28 How do you feel knowing that God will never grow weary?	Create a "Family Covenant." Consider basing it on Scripture. Display it in your home.	PSALM 24:10 Will God's kingdom ever end?	Make a cross with two craft sticks. Write the words "Forever" and "King" across the sticks. Decorate together.	Discuss the best advice you've ever received and why it was so great. READ TOGETHER: 1 Kings 3:3-15; 4:29-34 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
