





#### Solomon Builds the Temple (1 Kings 5-8)

Week 2

Brite Idea: God is present.

He Question: Where does God live?

God's home is in heaven, but He is omnipresent and can be everywhere at once. He wants to be with His people. The Holy Spirit lives within every follower of Jesus.

·· We Question: What does God's presence mean for us?

God is with us and we can have a relationship with Him through Jesus. We can pray to Him anytime, anywhere.

#### The Kingdom Divides (1 Kings 11-12)

Week 3

Brite Idea: God never gives up on us.

He Question: How does God feel about sin?

God is perfect and holy. He hates sin because it separates people from Him.

We Question: Does God still love us when we sin?

God loves us no matter what. There are consequences when we sin, but we can always have hope. God wants us to turn to Him and seek His forgiveness, which is available because of Jesus.

#### Elisha is Surrounded (2 Kings 6:8-23)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God is working, even when we don't see it.

He Question: Why can't we see God?

God is spirit. He is invisible, but He is real and always present. He is always working, and we can see the great things He does. • **We Question:** What do we do when it doesn't feel like God is working?

We can trust God and ask Him to help us have faith that He is working even though we can't see it.

#### Esther (Esther 2-8)

Week 5

Brite Idea: God always has a plan.

He Question: How can God have a plan for everything?

God is sovereign and in control. He loves us and knows what is best for the world.


We Question: Does God have a purpose for everyone?
