



## JOHN THE BAPTIST

**BIBLE PASSAGE:** Matthew 3:1–12; Luke 3:1–18

**FOCUS VERSES:** Philippians 2:9; Colossians 1:19–20;  
Matthew 6:33; John 3:30

**Summary:** Before Jesus was born, an angel told Zechariah that his wife Elizabeth would have a son named John. John would prepare the people for the coming Messiah and fulfill the prophecy of Isaiah. John grew up in the wilderness, preached repentance and baptized people in the Jordan River. He rebuked religious leaders for relying on tradition instead of true repentance. When people wondered if he was the Messiah, John said the true Messiah was coming, one mightier than him, who would baptize with the Holy Spirit.






### SOS

### JOHN THE BAPTIST (Matthew 3:1-12; Luke 3:1-18)

Week 1

**Brite Idea:** Jesus is greater than any person.

**He Question:** Who is Jesus?

### JESUS' BAPTISM AND TEMPTATION (Matthew 3:13-17, 4:1-17; John 1:29-34)

Week 2

**Brite Idea:** Jesus is God's Son.

**He Question:** How is Jesus different than other people?

Jesus is the Son of God. He is holy, perfectly good and never sinned.

**We Question:** How is Jesus like us?

Because Jesus came to Earth as a man, He experienced the same things we do. We can trust that He understands us and what we go through.

### THE DISCIPLES FOLLOW JESUS (John 1:35-51)

Week 3

**Brite Idea:** Jesus invites us to follow Him.

**He Question:** Why is Jesus worthy of being followed?

Jesus is the Son of God and the perfect example of how God wants us to live. He loves us more than anyone else can and showed that by paying the price for our sins.

**We Question:** What does it mean to follow Jesus?

We follow Jesus by trusting in Him as our Savior, seeking to know Him more and more and following His example in how we live our lives.

### JESUS DEMONSTRATES HIS POWER (Mark 4:35-5:20)

Week 4

**Brite Idea:** Jesus has power over everything.

**He Question:** How is Jesus so powerful?

Jesus showed that He is God and has God's power. He is omnipotent, and His power has no limits!

**We Question:** Is Jesus' power scary?

Jesus is 100 percent good and loves us so much. We can respond with awe and wonder at His amazing power.
