

## MARY AND MARTHA

**BIBLE PASSAGE:** Luke 10:38–42

**FOCUS VERSES:** Jeremiah 31:3b; John 15:5; James 4:8a;  
Psalm 145:18

**Summary:** Martha welcomed Jesus into her home. While Mary sat at Jesus' feet, listening to His teachings, Martha became busy with chores. Martha became frustrated and asked Jesus to tell Mary to help her. Jesus told Martha that she was distracted by many things, but only one thing truly mattered—spending time with Him.

### **He came to save us from our sin. (20 points)**

**Read:** John 3:16.

**Discuss:** According to this verse, how much does God love us?

### **He chose to. (25 points)**

**Read:** Ephesians 1:4.

**Discuss:** When did God choose to love us?

### JESUS HEALS ON THE SABBATH (Matthew 12:1-14)

Week 1

**Brite Idea:** Jesus is Lord of all.

**We Question:** Will following the rules make us right with God?

*No. We didn't do anything to make Jesus love us. We can't do anything that will make Him stop. He loved us so much that He died on the cross for our sin.*

### THE FEEDING OF THE 5,000 (John 6:1-15)

Week 2

**Brite Idea:** Jesus provides.

**He Question:** How is Jesus able to provide?

*Jesus is God and He is Lord over all things. Nothing is impossible for Him and everything belongs to Him.*

**We Question:** What can Jesus provide?

*Everything we have is a gift from Jesus. He knows our needs. We can trust He is able to provide according to His perfect will.*

### THE TRANSFIGURATION (Mark 9:2-13; Luke 9:28-36)

Week 3

**Brite Idea:** Jesus reveals God's glory.

**He Question:** What is God's glory?

*God's glory is His magnificence on display. By showing God's glory, Jesus showed He is fully God.*

**We Question:** How can we respond to who Jesus is?

*We can listen to Jesus and believe He is the Son of God. We can trust in Jesus as our Lord and Savior.*

Week 4


**Brite Idea:** Jesus wants a relationship with us.
