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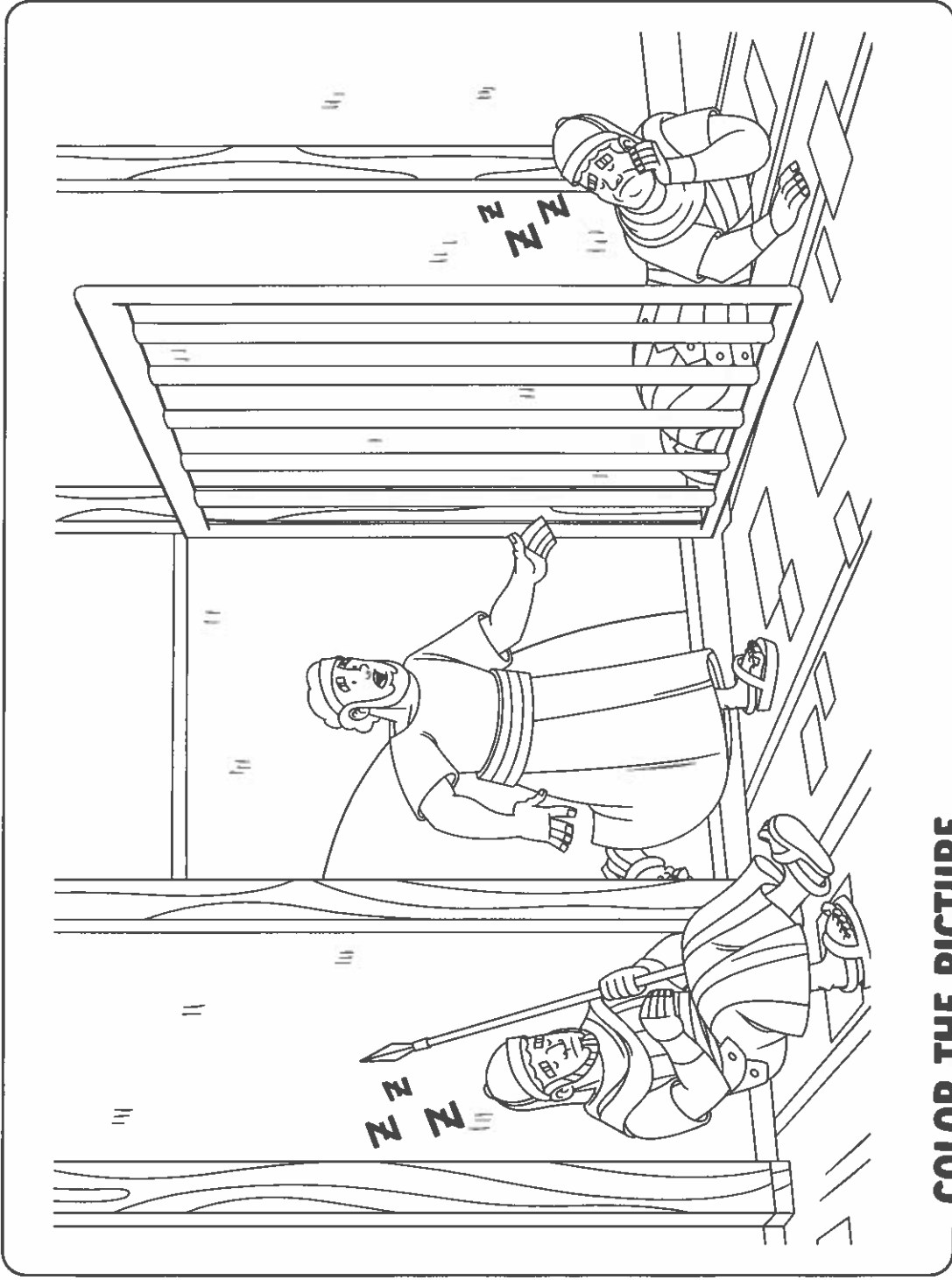

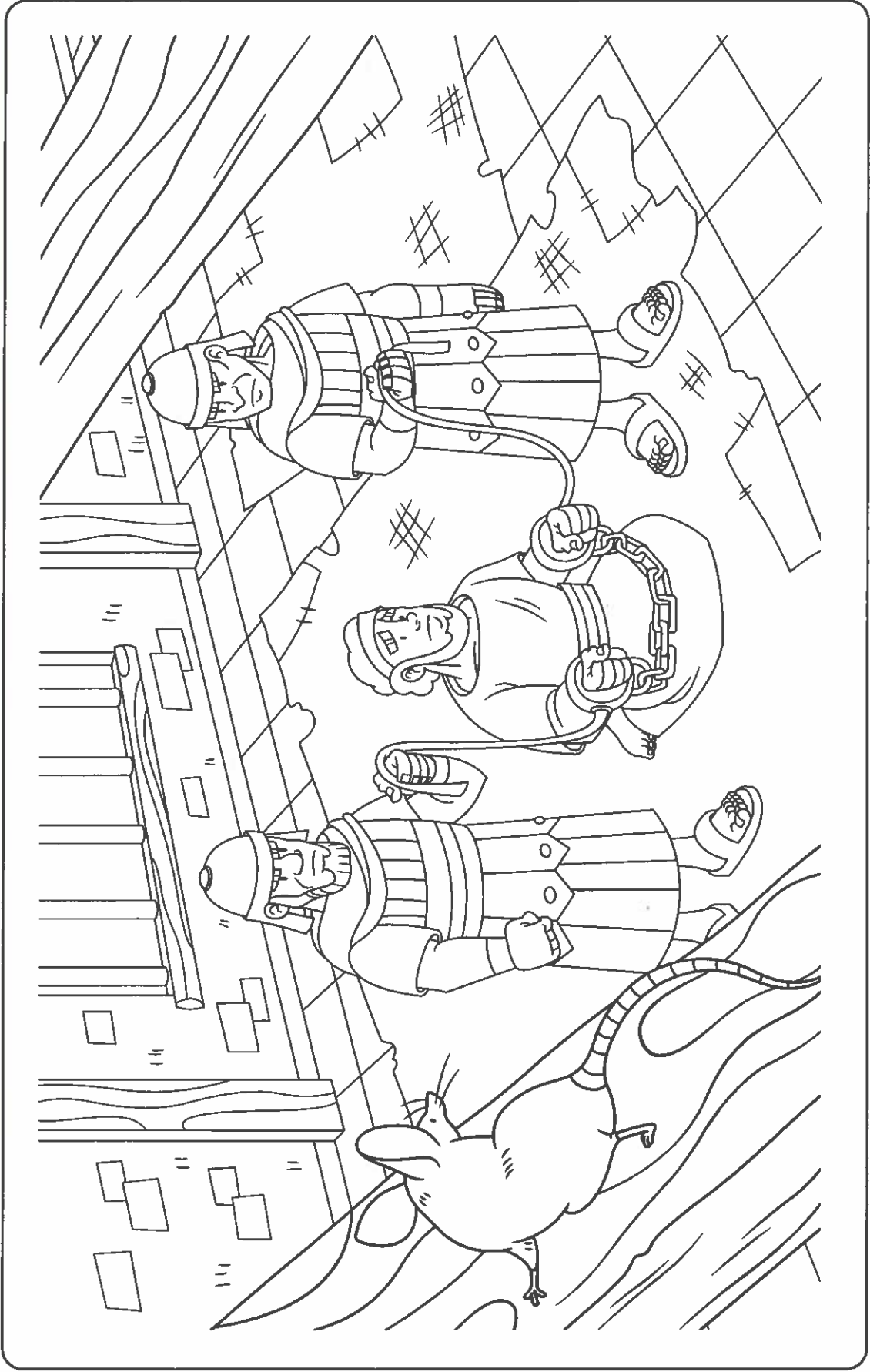

READ TOGETHER: Acts 18:18-28 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>

Include character traits you know about God.</p>	<p>Eat some fruit together. READ TOGETHER: Galatians 5:13-26 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?</p>
