



## FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

**BIBLE PASSAGE** GALATIANS 5:13–26

**Summary:** God sent Paul on missionary journeys. As Paul traveled, he told people about Jesus and started churches. He wrote letters to those churches, which now form part of the New Testament. Paul wrote to the Galatians and told them to live by the Spirit, not by the flesh. He shared with them that the fruit of the Spirit working in their lives was love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. We can only truly live like God wants us to by letting the Holy Spirit help us.

<b>WEEK 1</b> ..... The Holy Spirit helps us live like Jesus. What does this mean for me?	<b>READ TOGETHER:</b> John 13:15 How are we able to follow Jesus' example?	Come up with a tune that will help your family recite the fruit of the Spirit.	<b>HEBREWS 13:21A</b> How does God equip us with "everything good"?	Anytime you see a family member show a fruit of the Spirit, shout out that fruit. See who can spot and show the most fruit!	Name the fruit of the Spirit you see characters using in your favorite show or book. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Hebrews 11:1-12:2 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?
<b>WEEK 2</b> ..... God helps His people have faith. What does this mean for me?	<b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Hebrews 11:1 What is something we're certain of that we cannot see?	Play "catchphrase" using the heroes of faith in Hebrews 11.	<b>HEBREWS 13:21A</b> How does having faith in Jesus help us do God's will?	Craft "faith hero" ribbons or trophies to remind each other that we can all be heroes of faith when we allow God to help us.	Practice trust falls together. Talk about why you had faith you'd be safe. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> 1 & 2 Timothy <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?
<b>WEEK 3</b> ..... God helps us do His work. What does this mean for me?	<b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Philippians 2:13 How does it make you feel to know God takes pleasure in working through you?	Teach each other about something that is important to you, just as Paul and Timothy's mother and grandmother taught Timothy.	<b>HEBREWS 13:21A</b> How have you experienced God working through you?	Bless a neighbor with a meal or dessert and tell them you are showing love because God loves you!	Leave each other letters this week, like Paul left for Timothy. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> James 2:1-17 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?
<b>WEEK 4</b> ..... God helps us love others. What does this mean for me?	<b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Matthew 7:12 How have you shown God's love by treating others the way you wanted to be treated?	Take a love language quiz and learn how you each prefer to be loved.	<b>HEBREWS 13:21A</b> How does God work through you to show love to others?	Choose someone who has been difficult for you to love in the past and bless them in an unexpected way as a family.	Draw names from a hat and secretly show love to that family member throughout the week. <b>READ TOGETHER:</b> Psalm 19 <b>DISCUSS:</b> What does this teach us about God?
